## **THE EDUCATION THAT I WANT FOR THE FUTURE IN BRAZIL**

The issue of education in Brazil is a key issue to be addressed today, taking into account the long in the Brazilian education scenario, attributed through the political, economic and socio-cultural issues of education in the country.

Education and its basic foundational principles from the issues of public educational policies and educational pedagogical practices permeate all the paths to be studied in basic education and higher education. The greatest difficulties that can be found in elementary schools are the learning of the foreign language in which students are bound to learn only some grammatical structures and no-pragmatic way. In this way the attributes of the language of the English Language where all the skills and practices are put into play being fundamental to habilitation of their learning, thus becoming the student apt reader and speaker of the English language.

In the language schools, speaking, reading, writing and auditory skills are worked out by means of teaching materials addressed to each age group in a current and contextualized manner, different from what we have seen in basic education and even in the higher education that becomes decontextualized from school and didactic areas due to lack of management and government investments in which it should opt for the improvement of foreign language teaching in schools and a reformulation of this teaching that we currently have in the country.

## ENGLISH EDUCATION IN BRAZIL

The biggest problem when we talk about English Education in Brazil isn't the student learning English by law, all the Elementary and High Schools must offer its learning but in order to the student achieves fluency, he/she must have financial conditions to enrol him/herself in Language School, since the regular schools work only with instrumental English, or English for Specific Purpose, where they learn vocabulary and Grammar, but there isn't any focus on Listening or Conversation, fundamental to learn a second language.

This way, a student with financial condition and interest in learning English, must enrol him/herself in Language Schools such as Pbf, which work with "Levelling", student with similar levels study in the same group, small classes, 10 students, at most, and the focus is on *Communicative Approach*, in which the language is taught by the practice of Vocabulary, Grammar, Listening and Speaking. By working with this 4 abilities, students work with different abilities and get used with the new language.

Another differential of Language Schools is the teachers' fluency, which isn't required by the regular schools. While a teacher of Language School must have C1 Level, to teach in regular school is enough that the teacher has B1 or B2 levels, because he doesn't work with listening or speaking exercises.

## **THE BRAZILIAN EDUCATION SYSTEM**

The school career of children is broken up into different, progressive stages:

- . Elementary school – 06 to 14 years of age
- . High school – 15 to 17 years of age
- . Higher education – this occurs after schooling is complemented

School is compulsory for all children between 7 to 14 years of age. However, this is seldom enforced, as many children live in rural areas or have to work to make money for their families instead of spending time at school.

In terms of universities, there is a mixture of publicly and privately funded institutions. Publicly funded universities are completely financially supported by the government and offer a superior education to those that are privately-funded.

The Brazilian education system is composed of public and private schools. Even though public education still holds more 80% of their students, the number of students enrolled at private schools increased 14% from 2010 to 2013 according to the research Censo da Educação Básica, by INEP.

There are several reasons that justify the movement towards private institutions. One of them is that the rise of the lower classes has provided many families with the possibility to ensure their children a better education at private schools. The other is due to the fact that public schools still suffer from a lack of teachers, overcrowded classrooms, lack of security and general issues with infrastructure.
