Another important point is the modifications in secondary education, which for many may seem to have facilitated the lives of students and teachers, but it's not true - because it becomes harder for students to remember some contents in the end of the academic year – since we have lost annual contact with most of the school subjects.

# Renan Douglas Almeida Valença

Public education in Brazil is a reflection of an unstable political situation that the country is undergoing. Direction and coordination of public schools strive for – at least – provide basic education.

The first essential thing to obtain a quality education would be to offer components such as computers, a good quality internet service for researches and school supplies (to make classes more dynamic and not a tedious and uncomfortable environment).

Teachers deal with dozens, sometimes hundreds of students on a single day. Because of this, it would be essential that they increasingly acquire instructions to better manage people and, consequently, reflect on giving more productive classes.

To ensure a quality public education, it would be necessary teachers who deal well with their students and run more dynamic classes, together with a good provision of school material and technology to assist them in classroom.

# Hellen Kathleen Araújo Alvares

In Brazil, education has been showing some slips in recent years. High school has shown a very low rate of learning. According to data from the IDEB (Basic Education Development Index), only 50% of students complete the last three years of school – so the government has proposed changing education (so that it can improve results).

The BNCC (Common National Curriculum Basis) is responsible for this High school's transformation. It states, at the moment, the Mathematics and Portuguese will be compulsory subjects during all years of High school. Each student may choose other subjects as areas of knowledge. Professional courses will also be offered, in case the student prefers to do so. And when you finish, you will receive a certificate, which can help you enter the job market.

In addition, the BNCC also states that the workload will also be increased. The current class hours are 800 per year, and with this High school's change, it will be added another class each day, resulting in 1000 hours per academic year then. However, this can be a negative aspect of this transformation process, because it isn't the amount of study hours that will make one achieve better outcomes. Instead, students may become more tired

and disinterested in class. And this can generate a disharmony between students and teachers.

Another point is how the ENEM evaluation will look. No change has been defined, but it is possible that there is some, because if each students chooses an area of knowledge, the INEP, MEC and BNCC will need, together, to devise some form of proper evaluation for all students.

Therefore, for our country to achieve a good result in education through this High school remodeling, it is necessary that this government has flexibility and analyzes better the probabilities of this transformation, because what is presently defined can also have many negative results. Thus, Brazil may not achieve the desired index results any time soon.

# Calebe Cardoso de Aragão

I hope that in the future schools will offer more infrastructure, where adolescents and young people can enjoy better learning and have a more complex and dynamic teaching.

This can now be achieved quickly through a variety of technologies that have been used in schools to share information between students and teachers, such as distance learning and computer simulations. It is well known in the legal community that education is a human right, fundamental and unavailable. That is the duty of the State and the family. It therefore seems obvious that people with disabilities also have the right to education, but the statistics insist on demonstrating that in practice this right is far from being guaranteed. My purpose here is to demonstrate not only that people with disabilities have the same right, but also they have the right to exercise it without discrimination, that is, to be received and taught in the same space (class), as all other students. If they require specialized educational

services, they may be offered separately as a supplement, but never in order to prevent such students from having access to the common classroom. We know that no one consciously denies people with disabilities the right to education, however, given the practical difficulties they face, they often admit that this right would be provided if they were educated separately only in specialized settings. Sometimes they justify that it is for "their own good". Perhaps the arguments of "practical difficulties" in relation to people with disabilities, give way to the awareness that they also have this right unavailable, without differentiations that lead to exclusions in relation to people without disabilities.

We are also aware of the fact that it is stated: "As regards students with disabilities, this is different because they do not learn in the same way and we are talking about education; in addition, they need specific attention and perhaps they should not be obliged to attend school ". Now, the justification for not receiving women and others, minorities was not much different. It is enough that the school is transformed to accept the differences that even this question is overcome. The school that organizes itself to receive only students that reach a certain level of intellectual development is a school that excludes even people without any type of disability or special educational necessity (few who finish the course in the same school); is a school that creates hateful situations of competition between students of the same class; is a school that privileges so much the transmission of knowledge, that it forgets the human development and ends up undermining the personal and professional future of that individual. There are examples of schools that receive people with and without disabilities, in the same classroom or educational space, and who are

successful, both from a personal point of view and from the transmission of knowledge. (Bruna Eduarda Rodrigues)
